

CNU Epidemic Prevention Announcement for 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

People who entered Taiwan through a flight transfer in China, Hong Kong, Macao or Korea must conduct Home Quarantine for 14 days after entering Taiwan. It is forbidden to go out, take public transportation, or go to school or office during the 14 days. Those who fail to comply with central epidemic command and control measures will be fined according to the Communicable Disease Control Act and may be proceeded with compulsory placement when necessary.

In addition, starting from February 16th, the faculty and students who in the previous 14 days had a travel history to Singapore, Thailand or Japan are requested to carry out a 14-day Self-Management of Health. During the period of Self-Management of Health, people should avoid going out. If going out is necessary, they should wear a medical mask. They should also avoid going to school or office.

Last, during the period of Home Isolation, Home Quarantine or Self-Management of Health, people should check body temperature in the morning and evening every day, and report through the on-line CNU COVID-19 Epidemic Prevention Platform(<http://210.59.87.164/symns/>).
